REFLECTION on the word "relief"

We have a wonderful feeling, when after hours of suffering, we have relief from pain. An injection by a doctor may relieve the pain for a time.

The word "relief" has many associations. Shakespeare uses it of the changing of the King's Bodyguard, when the relieved soldier on duty says to the incoming soldier "For this relief, thanks".

The term "relief" also refers to when an outcrop stands out from the rest of the flat surface from which it is set. This gives a personal reference for there are those among us who stand out both by their character and their abilities. They give us a greater awareness of what being human can be.

Jesus stood out in a special way among the people of Palestine. His appeal was that he brought relief to the sick and disadvantaged. Crowds followed him. Despite his crucifixion and resurrection, it was when he ascended to the right hand of God that his disciples acknowledged who he was.
