REFLECTION..... on "the Trinity".

The word "Trinity" is reminiscent of the novel by Alexander Dumas, entitled
"The three Musketeers". Their motto was "All for one and one for all, united
we stand divided we fall". So, it is with our belief in the Trinity, we recite
"God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit". Separated as the
three Persons of the Trinity are, they express a unity in the way that each
fulfils their calling, addressing everyone with the Gospel of Jesus.

"The doctrine of the Trinity" was only mentioned indirectly by Jesus, but
became the agreed conclusion of theologians who met at the Council of
Nicaea,(AD 235).

The doctrine was wrongly presented to his people by Bishop Arius of the
North African Church. He claimed that if Jesus was the Son of God, then he
was less than God. Those assembled at the Council of Nicaea, felt that this
denigrated the Godhead and expelled him for heretical teaching.

Although the doctrine of the Trinity was conceived by a conference of
leaders of the Church, it nonetheless holds together the all-important truths
of the Gospel, of a loving Father who by His Spirit, gave His Son to redeem
the world.
